



Presentation of Invited Resource Persons SESSION I

Plenary Session:10 am to 11.30 am

Date: 15.9.2022

Day: Thursday

The meeting was started at 10.00 am. The Inaugural address was given by Dr.A.Subramanian, Principal, The M.D.T. Hindu College, Pettai. Dr.M.G. Sethuraman was introduced by Dr.C.Anitha, Dept of Chemistry, The M.D.T Hindu College.

Dr.C.Anitha has introduce the Resource person, Dr.M.G. Sethuraman. He has 32 years of experience in teaching and 37 years of experience in research. He published 2 books, 120 papers in proceedings and 144 publications in reputed journals. He organized more than 15 Conferences. He received many awards like MASCOT National Award-2018 and institutional social responsibility award -2018. He owned his responsibilities as director in R&D and IQAC.

Dr.M.G.Sethuraman took over the session. He discussed about the challenges faced by higher education. He started his presentation by telling about the quality metrics of higher education.

He listed the purpose of getting higher education, as higher education is for the production of qualified Human resources, for training the research career, for efficient management of Teaching profession and for the matter of extending career opportunities.

Then he discussed about the functions of Higher Education. Any System has learning centric, the system should meet student needs.ie., need of the student and should have zero defects.

He defined quality by saying, "Quality can attract more students. Organization should have social audit". The image and visibility also to be improved as more competition among the institutions giving higher education.

He insisted the importance of teaching methodologies, ambience is one of the important methodologies to give better environment to the students. Every institution should consolidate and concentrate on higher education as Quality dimensions are

in higher education. Good environment should meet smart classrooms, modern equipment, research centre, hostel facility, sports facility requirement.

He discussed the various approaches to access the quality as follows, Language proficiency, understanding the need of the students, availability of staffs clearing doubts of students are the essential attitudes of the teacher working in the institutions. Flexi credit system is needed to learn more to produce multi task student. So that the organization can enable them to come with multi skills instead of organization with rigid system.

He gave an idea about Statistical information about the research papers has i10 metrics or h metrics in an organization can access quality. Feedback from the
student can access quality, number of FIST, DST completed projects, fund
allotments can access quality ,number of Papers with more than 10 citation, can
access quality. Percentage of papers published in international database can access
quality.

He gave the desirable indicators as, number of interdisciplinary courses introduced in the last 5 years, number of faculty availing international fellowship, elearning resource enrolled by the staffs like NPTEL, Digital library etc, average pass percentage of students, 50% Government and 50% management seats to be allotted for the students.

Contribution of Alumni to the development of the institution by giving fund also acceptable. He insisted again the importance of quality as Quality only brings education to the next level. He introduced about "Quality assessment model". He said Self Assessment of the staff should be taken by every staff, ie., Self analysis of the staff by themselves every year can help to increase the quality of education.

He discussed about the parameters like NIRF, RP and Global university Ranking. He discussed variety of Ranking, where he discussed the percentage rate of reputation, faculty, citation per paper ,staffs with Ph.D.

Scholarship, Growth plan, Best practices for brain storming, Good book only judges the good environment to the students. Ranking increases the Competence. He finished the talk by saying about India's Economic Level.

He have the solution to develop India as development of India only can take over by the improvement of education.

SESSION II

Plenary session:11.30 am to 1 pm

Date: 15/9/22

Day: Thursday

Dr. Loghambal introduced Dr.B.Serena Margrets at 11.30am. Her topic is Role of IQAC in higher educational institutions. She insisted to learn several ambassador courses irrespective of academic excellence to get credit of higher educational institutions, since ARIIA ranking has questionnaires' to confirm whether we are conducting ambassador courses.

She told about the responsibility of desirable value systems like HEI among the students to groom them to get knowledge from value system. She mentioned the importance ICT enabled administrative process, since drive to development of excellence will be coming through analysing our strength and weakness.

She gave much importance in her speech on 3C's. They are conscience, confirmation and culture. These are important in data maintenance and psychological understanding in quality culture. She discussed about the metrics of institutions comes from KI factor and distribution of mark allotment among seven criteria.

She gave an idea, how to plan and file IQAC activities arranged by different action plans, skill development programmes, student induction programmes, capacity building initiatives. She discussed about the importance of filing, as ancient knowledge system have to be incorporated with the shadow of new activity. She gave an example for incorporating as, how to upload UGC activity, by designing portal, and E-voting software also to be encouraged in certain Portal.

She presented four different audits like AQAR, AAA, Greenaudit, energy audit. Out of them, energy audit and green audit will be done by central government, we have to register it, the members of that Particular panel give us guidelines. AQAR updated only in the month of April.

Usually IQAC system with over flowing data can have digital lock, submitting financial statement for academic or non academic essentials is also important to keep it separate. She discussed about the contents of activity that will assure the quality of organization by annual log, MOOC's file, E-content videos.

Annual log has magazine activities of IQAC. MOOC's file has a list of student courses broadly divided into two as, NPTEL –local chapter to get silver ranking and active courses to account the number of students who are getting pass marks run by IIT Madras. Whereas E-content videos are the videos with animation can also to be added.

She gave an example as, one of her student passed seven NPTEL Courses in four semesters have got award in southern region. She gave the idea about filing NAAC sponsored seminar's short video posted on youtube, entrepreneurship centre of excellence can conduct programme courses after getting feedback from BOS academic council.

She explained the importance of mentors, mentee report, since the mentor, mentee report accounts the number of students attended competitive exams, the number of students for getting internship and projects, the number of students attended certificate courses that groom the students employable.

She discussed about Grievance redressal committee, that always monitor the records of all criterias, department files, experience of faculties, teaching and learning programme which are to be unique. Students attending extention activities has to be registered in the links and those links also to be created by institutions in their own server.

Finally she finished the session with the quote, "success is the sum of all small efforts, repeated day in day out".

At 12.55pm Saumana Datta asked questions to her, she replied well.At 12.58, Dr.Logambhal gave the notes of vote of thanks.

Dr.P. Velmani introduced Dr. N. Ponpandian ,Head and Professor of Physics, Department of Nanoscience and Technology, Bharathiyar university,Coimbatore.

His topic is "The role of IQAC in maintaining quality standards in teaching, learning, Evaluation and Research".

He explained why do we need Accreditation. He insisted the importance of Higher Education to pursue Accreditation.

The total vision of NAAC from different core values will contribute national development. He explained seven of concept NAAC, they are

- 1. Curriculam development choice based credit system
- Teaching, Learning process
- 3. Research and Development
- 4. Infrastructure Development
- Students support
- 6. Governance and Leadership
- 7. Innovative and Best practices

He gave an idea about how to implement the outcome based education.

He explained detail about the importance of outcome even though the student is feeling sick, or student not able to attend the external exam, He gave a solution to overcome from the issues.

He gave various step involving, Teaching-Learning process. They are four,

- Higher education
- 2. Syllabus on the university
- 3. Deliver the Curriculam
- 4. Improve the Teaching, Learning process

He gave an idea to enhance teacher quality by asking them to attend online courses as it is very easy. He explained how to improve the quality through fast learners and slow learners.

He gave evaluating methods to judge the students by making them to attend courses, and use to conduct some event to test their writing skill, finally we can ask them to attend oral exam.

He explained about the innovative making research worth he gave examples and he gave suggestion to improve innovativeness in research.

Every institution has to have a separate portal, where they can enter the details of students feedback and the score also to be transparent.

DVV query will be coming after submission of SSR and with in 15 days only be the time to respond to DVV query.

After accepting the mail, principle will give 3 slots for the visit. Locked SSR is uploaded on the college website till the grade is received all should be digitally processed. The system generates QN score + qc score +SSS score will be the final score. He explained online A&A methodology as follows,

SSR document should not exceed 5MB it should not be uploaded on Google drive .Neat scanning of documents ,Geo tagged photos.

Number of clicks also important.

We have to upload only necessary document.

Data validation and verification (DVV) for Qn related matrices.

He told about intended document ,as we have to check weblink is connected with particular document.

He instead to enter in data template about number of students, number of outgoing students ,number of classrooms and number of expenditure .He finished and he insisted again that matching extending profile is important.

He thanked the management of IQAC and congratulate them to conduct such conference like this in future can improve the quality of education.

He explained that nanocomposites are materials formed by combining a matrix and nanoparticle filler, typically on the scale of nanometres. These materials possess unique properties due to their nanoscale structure, such as improved strength, stiffness, and thermal stability.

He went on to explain how these nanoparticles can be of different types, such as metals, oxides, and polymers. The resulting nanocomposites exhibit unique properties, such as increased strength, stiffness, and thermal stability, which make them ideal for use in a wide range of applications.

Dr. Aul Kashmir Arulraj then proceeded to share his insights on how to achieve a good position in academics in the field of nano composites. He emphasized the importance of developing a strong foundation in the basics of materials science, nanotechnology, and chemistry. To succeed in this field, one needs to have a solid understanding of these fundamental concepts.

He also stressed the importance of staying up-to-date with the latest developments in the field. The field of nanocomposites is constantly evolving, and new developments are being made all the time. Therefore, it is essential to keep abreast of the latest research papers and patents. Furthermore, Dr. Aul Kashmir Arulraj encouraged collaboration among researchers in the field of nanocomposites. Collaboration is essential in this field since it involves the integration of different disciplines, such as chemistry, physics, and materials science. Therefore, it is essential to collaborate with others and to build strong research networks.

Followed by the lunch break, the second technical session commenced promptly at 2:30 p.m. with Dr. K. Muthu, Assistant Professor of Chemistry at The Manonmaniam Sundaranar University, Tirunelveli. In this Session Dr. K. Muhu emphasized the importance of Nanotechnology, he told that, this is a field where the border between the traditional disciplines like physics, chemistry and biology is no longer detectable and interesting synergies arise, e.g., instruments developed in physics provide the precision and sensitivity to perform specific molecular recognition experiments in biology. The roots of NSST go back to Feynman. The originator of the famous sentence "There is plenty of room at the bottom".

His focus was on tools based mainly on electron microscopes, stressing the importance of the nanometer in precision mechanics. The breakthrough occurred with new types of microscopes (SPM), materials (carbon-based fullerenes, nanotubes and quantum dots), mesoscopic systems, new trends in iniaturization based on the view of chemists and the vision that nature is the best example of nanotechnology. He explained the various methods of synthesis of nano compounds and clarified the doubts raised by the audience.

RTPS 2023 REPORT

The report of A Two Day National Seminar on Recent Trends in Physical Sciences RTPS 2023, organized by P.G. & Research Department of Physics, The M.D.T.Hindu College, Tirunelveli on 02.02.2023 & 03.02.2023. The primary purpose of this seminar was to discuss semiconductor applications, Crystal growth applications, Space world and the super capacitor based applications. Around 100 Research Scholars and P.G. students, 85 U.G. students participated in this seminar.

INAUGURAL SESSION

Dr.K.Balasubramanian, Convener & Head, P.G. & Research Department of Physics delivered the Welcome address. He welcomed the Resource Person Dr.R.Imran Khan, Senior Research Fellow, IISC, Bangalore, Mr.B.T.Chidambaram, Treasurer, College Committee, Mr.Thalavai R.Thirumalaiappan, Member, College Committee, Dr.A.Subramanian, Principal, Dr.P.Sekar, Vice Principal, Committee Member Mr.G.Bethanasamy, Associate Professor of Computer Science as well as other Department Heads, Faculties and Participant from various colleges.

This Seminar was inaugurated and delivered the Presidential address by Mr.B.T.Chidambaram, Treasurer, College Committee. Mr.Thalavai R.Thirumalaiappan, Member, College Committee and Dr.A.Subramanian, Principal delivered the felicitation address and the Inaugural session was ended with the Vote of Thanks given by Dr.D.Guruvammal, Assistant Professor of Physics.

TECHNICAL SESSION I

The very first session about the vital role of Organic compounds for sustaining life on earth and include complex molecules like genetic information bearing deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA) and proteins that constitute essential compounds of our blood, muscles and skin. Organic compounds appear in materials like clothing, fuels, polymers, dyes and medicines. Some of the important areas of application of these compounds are also explained in a clear manner particularly the medicinal field.

TECHNICAL SESSION II

Contrast to the first session, the emerging applications and concepts behind the same of inorganic compounds is explored in the session II. The session highlighted the significant advances in metal-halide perovskite semiconductors that influenced light-current conversion technologies. Further, the excellent structural and compositional tunability of perovskites, coupled with their exceptional quantum yields for photoluminescence, and the session justified metal-halide perovskite semiconductors as a promising candidate for optoelectronic devices.

TECHNNICAL SESSION III

The invited speaker gave a very fundamental aspects of intermolecular interactions in session III. The speaker explained about intermolecular forces between the atoms, molecules, ions in condensed states such as liquid or solid mainly in the crystals. In addition, how this intermolecular forces determine bulk properties, such as the melting points and the boiling points of crystals. The types of intermolecular forces which influenced the bonding in crystals and its applications in day-today life are also discussed.

Day 2 (03.02.2023)

TECHNICAL SESSION I

Session I in day 2 dealt about the crystals which are minerals that hold energy, and as we as humans are made up of energy, we can exchange energy with the crystal when we work with it. The session pointed out that crystals are used to improve the function of many everyday objects, like watches, plugs, hospital equipment, and lasers. Quartz and the gemstones, often occur as single crystals; synthetic single crystals, especially silicon and gallium arsenide, are used in solid-state electronic devices such as integrated circuits and light-emitting diodes (LEDs).

TECHNICAL SESSION II

A very distinguished session entitled above was immensely attracted the participants in which the invited speaker shared the ideas behind how the planet earth's angle is calculated, time for a day is determined and various aspects of human's search for life was discoursed. The session also conferred the life exists on other planets and its inherent importance, origin-of-life research guides the search for extra-terrestrials.

TECHNICAL SESSION III

The final session of this national seminar conversed about the application of graphene based material for super capacitor applications. The session initially started with the explanation of importance of energy storage and working principle of super capacitors, its types and detailed about how boron-incorporated graphene is used in the super capacitor application and its performance is also deliberately detailed. The recent aspects of super capacitors in energy storage is also briefed in this session.
