HISTORICAL SKETCH

The Hindu College, Tirunelveli, the oldest First Grade Institution in Tirunelveli District and the Alma mater of most of the distinguished sons of Tirunelveli, offers unique opportunities of higher education to boys and girls of all creeds, castes and communities in the district. It was started as a Second Grade College in 1878. As a Second Grade College the Institution was the pride of Tirunelveli District and it became one of the most efficient colleges in the presidency and richly deserved its primacy of honour. Encouraged by the brilliant success of the Institution as a Second Grade College, the Management of 1924 thought it advisable to raise it to the First Grade in order to enable it to share in the larger activities of the University under the Madras University Act of 1923. The name of the institution was changed to "The Madurai Diraviyam Thayumanavar Hindu College" on the 23rd January 1936 on receipt of a munificent donation of a lakh and one rupees from Mr. Ry. M. Diraviyam Pillai Avl. of Madurai.

From 1939 onwards, the Institution has been growing steadily and the Educational Society which runs the college felt that the space at the Tirunelveli Junction Campus was not sufficient to meet the growing needs of the college. They decided to shift the college to the New Campus at Pettai. About 85 acres of land was purchased and buildings were constructed. The college was shifted to the New campus at the beginning of the year 1958-59.

The college which completed 100 years of fruitful service to the cause of collegiate Education in 1978 celebrated its centenary on the 14th, 15th and 16th of April 1979. The then Prime Minister of

India inaugurated the celebrations under the presidentship of the then Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu. Our college celebrated the post centenary silver jubilee valedictory function on January 3rd 2005. Hon'ble Finance Minister of India Shri. P. Chidambaram was the Chief Guest of the August function. The College was Reaccredited with B+ Grade by NAAC in third cycle in the month of September 2018.

COLLEGE MOTTO

COLLEGE CREST

The college crest consists of the picture of Goddess Saraswathi, a sheaf of corn and a torch.

'The Sheaf of Corn' represents fertility and is symbolic of Tirunelveli Town where the college is situated.

'The Torch', represents enlightenment.

COLLEGE REGULATIONS

COLLEGE REGULATIONS

GENERAL DISCIPLINE

1. Every student should wear a clean and presentable uniform introduced by the college.
2. Every student should greet the members of the staff when he/she meets them for the first time during the day.
3. When the member of the staff enters into the class room the students shall get up and remain standing till they are asked to sit or the member of the staff takes his / her seat.
4. Every student is expected to bring himself the required books in every subject.
5. Every student shall aim at such behaviour in the classroom that he/she shall not in the least create any disturbance.
6. Every student shall endeavour to attend classes regularly and shall refrain from doing anything calculated to affect the attendance of the other students.
7. Every student shall sit in the place assigned to him/her in the classroom.
8. Students coming late to the class shall enter only with the permission of the teacher.
9. No student is permitted to leave the class before the end of the period.
10. Students should not loiter about the college campus or stand in groups in the approaches to the college. They should ensure a calm atmosphere of study and orderliness.

11. Students attending lectures, working in laboratories or attending meetings shall maintain perfect silence.

12. Students getting out of a classroom or moving from one classroom to another shall do so in an orderly manner without making noise.

13. Irregular attendance, insubordination to teachers, habitual indifference to class work, obscenity in word or action and such other conduct considered to be unbecoming of a student shall be dealt with severely.

14. Students should handle college property with care and endeavour to preserve the cleanliness of the buildings, furniture and college campus. Any damage done to the properties of the college inadvertently will be made good at the cost of the student concerned. Any wilful damage will be seriously dealt with.

15. Smoking is strictly prohibited within the college campus.

16. No student shall bring into the college premises pets unauthorised books or other objectionable articles of any kind.

17. No notice or petition of any kind shall be circulated among the students or put on the notice board or anywhere within the college premises without the written sanction of the Principal.

18. Students are forbidden to organise meetings in the college or collect money for any purpose without the permission of the Principal.

19. The attention of students is drawn to the following Disciplinary Regulations for colleges issued by the Government of Tamilnadu for strict compliance.

a. Students should abstain from active participation in party or communal politics.

b. Principal of the college or hostel authorities may frame and issue from time to time disciplinary rules of a permanent or temporary character regulating the conduct, outside the college or hostel precincts, of students on the rolls so far as such rules seem necessary to maintain the credit, usefulness and reputation of the college or hostel.

c. Principal or other constituted college or hostel authorities shall have power to inflict punishments, in the interests of the institution.

20. No social function shall be held within the college campus without the permission of the Principal.

21. Students are expected to project and promote the fair image of the college.

IDENTITY CARD

Every student must possess an identity card during college hours and produce it on demand by any member of the staff at any time.

CLASS HOURS

1. The working hours are from 10.00 am to 4.00 pm having five periods of one hour duration.

2. The first bell is rung five minutes before the beginning of the session and the second bell at the hour fixed for the commencement of the class. Students are expected to take their seats in their respective class rooms before the second stroke of the bell. The bell shall also be rung at the end of each period.

PRAYER

At the stroke of the second bell a prayer song is played on the Public Address System when all shall stand and pray silently till the song is over. Any student who is on his way to his class when the prayer song is played shall stop immediately and

proceed only after the prayer song is over.

ATTENDANCE AND LEAVE OF ABSENCE

1. Every student shall attend college regularly and punctually on all working days.
2. Attendance is marked at the beginning of each class hour. While answering attendance the student shall stand in his place.
3. A student who is not in the class room when attendance is marked, shall lose attendance for the session.
4. One day's attendance means presence at all the lecture hours, seminars and practicals.
5. A student, in order to appear for the University Examination, should have a minimum attendance in accordance with the University regulations.
6. Attendance in each semester shall be entered in the progress report.
7. No student shall be absent himself/herself from the college without applying for leave. In case of sickness for more than three days, the leave application must be accompanied by a Medical Certificate.
8. Application for leave in the prescribed forms, counter signed by the parent or guardian, and in the case of hostelers by the Deputy Warden concerned must be submitted to the Principal in advance of the date on which leave is desired. When absence is due to unforeseen causes, an application for leave must be submitted as soon as possible and in any case not later than the first day of return to college. Leave will ordinarily be granted when proper reasons are given.

9. A student absenting himself from college for more than fifteen consecutive working days without satisfactory explanation is liable to have his name struck off the rolls.

MEDICAL EXAMINATION

1. Every newly admitted student is medically examined by a qualified Doctor.
2. Students found to suffer from some defect or disease must undergo treatment at their own expense and submit the result thereof to the college office signed by the Medical Officer.

CERTIFICATES

Term Certificate :

Term Certificates are not granted to students unless they show satisfactory progress during the year by their regularity of attendance, diligent application to work and securing the required percentage of marks in the various tests.

- a. A student must attend class not less than three fourths of the prescribed working days and complete the course of study.
- b. Science students must perform the practical work of experiments prescribed in Science subjects and submit their records regularly to the teachers.

Conduct Certificate :

Conduct Certificates are issued to students usually at the end of their courses of study.

Individual teachers decline to issue any conduct or attainment certificate in the absence of the general certificate issued by the Principal on behalf of the college.

Sports Certificate :

Only students who evince keen interest in Athletics and Games by regular participation are eligible to receive sports certificates at the end of their course.

Application for certificates - Transfer, Conduct, Course and Date of Birth - must be made in prescribed forms and will be received in the office on all working days. The certificates will be issued 24 hours after the receipt of applications.

Certificates will not be issued to students who are in arrears of fee, fine etc., or to those for whom library books etc., are due.

A student who leaves the college before completing the course without the written permission of the Principal is not eligible to get any certificate.

FEE REGULATION

1. The academic year is divided into two semesters.
2. Every student is liable to pay the whole fee for each semester during any part of which his/her name is on the rolls of the college and his/her attendance registered.
3. A student shall not be enrolled or admitted after beginning of a semester unless he/she has paid all the fees, which he/she would have had to pay, had his/her name been on the rolls from the beginning of the semester.
4. If a student leaves the college during the second or other semesters thereafter he shall have no right to claim a remission of any portion of the fee.
5. The tuition fees shall be paid per Semester. Special fees for the year shall be paid along with the tuition fee for the odd semester. Newly admitted students have to pay their fees without arrears.

6. If a student fails to pay his/her fees on the stipulated day fixed for the payment, a fine at the rate of Re. 1/- per working day shall be levied. If the fee is not paid within the date prescribed, the student's name shall be struck off the rolls. If re-admitted, in addition to the fees and fines due he/she shall pay a readmission fee of Re. 1/-. The names of defaulters will be published on the notice board. Students in arrears will not be permitted to attend the classes or to appear for examination.

7. Holders of Scholarships, Government or College are, bound by all foregoing rules. They should pay their fees on the days prescribed. Scholarships are disbursed to them as and when received.

8. Final Semester candidates should also remit fee prescribed by the University for the issue of Provisional Certificate.

REMITTANCE OF FEES

All fees shall be directly remitted into the college Office.

SCHOLARSHIP FEE CONCESSION

Half fee and full fee concessions under Rule 92 of the Tamilnadu Educational Rules are awarded to eligible students who submit necessary community and income certificates, within the stipulated time.

PROFICIENCY SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarships are annually awarded to poor students of decided ability. The award is being made on the basis of merit.

These concessions should be applied for only after the student has paid first semester fee in full and been enrolled in the college. The necessary application forms for the above scholarships may be received from the college office.

7. Thiru. P. Kuppaswami Iyer Memorial Scholarship:

(Instituted by Thiru. K. Sivaraman B.Sc)

Awarded to a Brahmin student of B.A., B.Sc.,B.Com., Degree Class, who scores the highest but not less than 60% of the marks in the aggregate in the qualifying examination for admission to the Degree Class and whose parents' income does not exceed Rs. 3000/- P.A.

8.Karukurichi Sri.S. Sivaramakrishna Iyer and Srimathi Subbulakshmi Ammal Memorial Scholarship:

(Instituted by Dr. S.Lakshmivarathan, University of Oklahoma, USA)

Awarded to two students, one in the II B.Sc., Maths, class and the other in the III B.Sc., Physics class who score the highest marks aggregate in their part III subjects.

9. Singapore Sri K.Krishnan Iyer Memorial Scholarship

(Instituted by Thiru. K. Krishna Iyer, Singapore)

Awarded to two Brahmin students of III B.Sc., Chemistry and III B.Com., who score the highest marks aggregate in their part III subjects.

10. Lions' Club of Palayamkottai Memorial Scholarship

(Instituted by Lions' Club Palayamkottai)

Awarded to the student of III B.Sc., Zoology who secures the highest marks in the aggregate in part III Subjects.

11. Bharathi Centenary Memorial Scholarship

(Instituted by Parent - Teacher Association, The M.D.T Hindu College)

Awarded to a poor, deserving student joining M.A., Tamil selected by the Honorary Secretary and the Principal. The award will be continued during II M.A., provided the student's progress is satisfactory.

12. Lions' Club of Tirunelveli Scholarship

Awarded to the son / daughter of a member of the non teaching staff and if there is no such student, to the son / daughter of a member of the teaching staff and in the absence of such a one to any other student. He shall be in II B.A / B.Sc / B.Com./ Class and should have secured the highest marks in part II English in the I year University Examination and not in receipt of any financial assistance.

13. Sri.M. Somasundaram Pillai and Srimathi Ramalakshmi Scholarship

(Instituted by Thiru.S. Muthuvel) Awarded to a deserving student belonging to Saiva Vellalar Community in the I year Degree Class. The student will continue to enjoy the award throughout his degree course.

14. Thirumathi, M. Pitchammal Scholarship:

(Instituted by Thiru. K. Thayumanaswamy Hereditary Member, Madurai) Awarded to a student who joins any P.G. Degree course other than M.A., Tamil having done the Degree course in our college. The scholarship shall be continued during the II P.G. Degree class also.

15. Thiru. M. Meenakshisundaram Pillai Scholarship:

(Instituted by Thiru. M. Ramaswamy M.A., Former, Principal)
The interest may be awarded as Scholarship to a good but poor student of any community not receiving any financial help from any other sources and studying in the B.Sc/B.Com/B.A Course in our college.

16. Selvi M. Valliammal Ammaiyar Scholarship:

(Instituted by Thiru. M. Ramaswamy M.A., Former, Principal)
The interest may be awarded as Scholarship to the student during the second year of the degree course who received Thiru. M.Meenakshisundaram Pillai Scholarship during the I year of the degree course and whose character, conduct and progress have been continuously good. If not, it may be awarded to another poor good student, if not, it may be awarded to another poor good student of II year B.Sc/B.Com/B.A/ degree course of any community not enjoying any other financial assistance.

17.Thirumathi M. Parameswari Thayammal and Thiru. P. Muthiah Pillai Scholarship:

(Instituted by Thiru. M. Ramaswamy M.A. Retd. Principal)
The interest may be awarded as Scholarship to the student of III year degree course who received selvi M. Valliammal Ammayar Scholarship during the 2nd year of the course and whose character, conduct and progress have been continuously good. If not, it may awarded to any other poor and good student doing his III year B.Sc./B.Com./B.A. and not receiving any financial help from any other source.

18. Thiru. M. Ramasubbu Konar Endowment Scholarship:

(Instituted by the Managing Committee, The Educational Society) Awarded to a student who gets and produces the maximum number of prizes and certificates in Elocution or Quiz competitions conducted by various Bodies or Educational Institutions. If not, the Scholarship is to be given to the winner of Essay, or Poetry competitions.

19. Medai Dalavai Kumarasamy Mudaliar Endowment Scholarship:

(Instituted by the Statue Installation Committee) Awarded only to a poor, bright student whose parents are not able to educate their ward without scholarships.

One Scholarship shall be awarded to a student who joins the I year P.G class & who secures good marks in the U.G. University Examinations. The Scholarship shall be continued for the II year P.G Class provided the recipient passes all the I year papers without arrears. The scholarships shall be given to two students who join the year I U.G. class and who have secured good marks in the Higher Secondary Examinations. The Scholarship shall be continued for the II & III Year U.G Classes provided the recipients pass all the papers in the respective University Examination without arrears.

20. Endowment in the name of R. Muthu Chidambara Shunmuga Vadivoo alias Deivanai alias Vellammal W/o.Thiru.C.A.K. Ratnasabapathy

(President, 1969 -71 and Treasurer 1976 -77, The Educational Society, Tirunelveli) Instituted by her son Thiru. C.A.R. Shunmuga Chidambaram alias Kutty, Former Treasurer, The Educational

Society Tirunelveli, and her daughter -in. law Thirumathi Chellammal alias Shakunthala Kutty on the occasion of the celebration of the Silver Jubilee of their Wedding on 7.12.1995, out of the funds raised by them from their family friends to the tune of Rs. 1,00,000/- (Rupees one lakh only).

60% of the interest should be given to a III year Zoology student who secures the highest marks in Zoology in the university exams. 40% of the interest should be given to a student of II year Zoology who has secured the first mark in Zoology. Both Prizes should be given in the form of books as per the students' wish or useful books for the students.

27. Thiru.A.Kailasam Chettiar and Mrs. K.Gomathi Ammal

(Instituted by Thiru.A.Kailasam Chettiar, Sindupoon durai)

Awarded to a II year Computer Science student belonging to Saiva Vellalar, Saiva Chettiar or Vellalar Chettiar community who secures

higher marks in the university exams and without any financial help from any other sources.

(Instituted by Thiru. C. Neelakanda Pillai, Dept. of Commerce) For conducting seminars / guest lectures and meetings to be organised by the Dept. of Commerce in our college

32. Thiru. I.C. Iswaran English Prize (Scholarship)

Instituted by Thiru. I.S. Kanthimathinathan, Reader and Former HOD of the English Dept.)

Awarded to a student of the college open to all UG and PG classes considered most competent in English.

33. Thiru. S. Natarajapillai Endowment (Instituted by Thiru. K.N. Mariappan, Jr. Asst. (SG) of our college)

Awarded to a student of the I year Computer Science belonging to a Saiva Vellala Community who is economically backward.

34. Sri. Sirungeri Sankaracharya Swamigal Endowment Scholarship

The Student should have passed in all subjects. 80% of attendance is must. The student should not have got any other scholarship from Govt. or from any other sources. Students' conduct and morality should be good.

35. Thiru. Pudumaipithan Century Memorial Endowment Prize:

This cash prize is instituted by The M.D.T. Hindu College & School Old Students' Association on the occasion of the Mupperum Vizha held in our school on 13th February 2006 with a corpus fund of Rs. 40000/- (Rupees Forty Thousand only) of which Rs. 35000/- was contributed by the Old Students' Association and Rs. 5000/- by Mrs. Dinakari Chockkalingam's daughter of Thiru. Pudumaipithan. The interest received from the corpus fund is to be utilised for awarding three cash prizes every year to the best three short stories in Tamil written by our college students. (Instituted by Secretary ALS Memorial Endowment Committee)

(15 % of the interest shall be spent for the function to be held on 5th September every year)

Of the remaining 85%

50% for school students and 50% for college students

For College : After disbursing the scholarship to the school students the remaining amount shall be equally awarded to the student of The MDT Hindu College who scores highest marks in the first 4 semesters. I year, II year in B.A. Economics Tamil Medium, B.A. Economics English Medium, B.Com., B.Sc. Maths, Physics, Chemistry, Zoology, Computer Science & Physical Education.

The interest amount accrued from the corpus fund will be distributed to the beneficiaries during the donors day function as per the condition of the Endowment.

50. Kokkirakulam,Thiru.M.Siva Ramachandran Memorial Endowment (Rs.1,00,000/-)

(Instituted by Dr. K. Balasubramanian, Associate Professor of Physics - 25.06.2021)

Awarded to a deserving UG Science Student who has scored the highest mark in Part - III subject and also he should pass the entire subjects in 1st attempt itself.

GOVERNMENT SCHOLARSHIPS TO COLLEGE STUDENTS

Proceeding of the Director of Collegiate Education, Madras - 6. R.C. No. 009661/ Tha 3/90 dt. 1/2/90. Sub : Collegiate Education - Availability of Scholarship to students in colleges.

For full details refer to the booklet containing All National Scholarships awarded by the Government of India. The booklet is available in the College Library.

1. National Scholarships are awarded by the Government of India. Only Indian Citizens who pass the qualifying examinations with atleast 60% marks in the aggregate are eligible.

2. State Scholarship for the children of the Working School Teachers - The Scholarship will be given to all recognised full time college courses of education after plus two stage. Only Indian nationals are eligible. Only those students who pass the examinations from Tamilnadu in the first division (or secure atleast 60 % marks in aggregate) are eligible.

3.State Government Merit Scholarship Scheme - Brilliant students who come first in the S.S.L.C. and Central Board of Secondary Education Examination (Who come first in Tamilnadu

in Std. X) are eligible.

4. Scholarship in Jawarharlal Nehru University School of International Studies, New Delhi. Available to a bonafide resident of Tamilnadu intending to take up the M.Phil., Ph.D., courses for advanced studies of International Affairs, open to candidates of either sex who should normally be below 25 years of age.

5. Scholarship at the Rashtriya Indian Military College Dehradun - Available for Indians as well as Anglo Indian candidates who secure admission in the Rashtriya Indian Military College, Dehra Dun.

6. Award of Scholarship to Cadets belonging to Tamilnadu in the National Defence Academy, Kahadekvasla - Maharashtra State Scholarship of Rs. 80 is awarded to the Cadet Selected on 9.9. Merit - cum - Means basis in each course in the National Defence Academy. Six Scholarships at the rate of Rs. 40 per month are available to six other cadets belonging to Tamilnadu and prosecuting their studies there.

7. Educational concession and Scholarship to the children of repatriates from Sri Lanka. To the children of repatriates from Sri Lanka who have arrived in India after 1st November 1964 with effect from the academic year 1967 - 68. Admissible only to those students the income of whose parents is not more than Rs. 500/- per month. Students who have secured 50% of marks will be eligible for the award of the assistance in the Degree Classes.

8. Educational concession and Scholarship to the children of repatriates from Burma who have arrived in India after 1st June 1963 with effect from 1966-67. The concessions are admissible

only to those students, the income of whose parents is not more than Rs. 400/- per month. Students who have secured 50% of marks will be eligible for the award of the assistance in the degree classes.

9. Schemes of scholarship to student from Non - Hindi speaking State for Post Matric Studies in Hindi. To encourage the study of Hindi in non-Hindi speaking states and to make available to the Governments of these states suitable personnel to teaching and other posts where knowledge of Hindi is essential.

10. Concessions awarded by the State Government to the children of those who had undergone imprisonment to the cause of Indian Independence. 11. Scholarship to the Children, Dependents of Defence Service Personnel. The Educational concession to the children as well as brothers, sisters, adopted children of the serving personnel belonging to the categories of Junior Commissioned Officers, members of the armed forces of all ranks if and when they resume their studies after their release from the armed forces, children of

civilian personnel working in the defence forces with military ranks, children of the defence forces with military ranks, children of Territorial Army personnel, wives of the defence personnel and to the children, adopted children, brothers and sisters of defence service personnel belonging to all ranks including a rank higher than that of junior commissioned officer who are either serving or mission or killed incapacitated in action.

12. Jawarharlal Nehru Science Talent Book Scheme.

Students selected will be given science books of reputed authors. Students who have secured maximum marks in std. XII Examination will be selected.

13. National Loan scholarship Scheme :

To provide financial assistance to the needy and meritorious students so as to enable them to pursue their college education. The loan scholarship will be given to all recognised full time college courses of education and training for studies in India only.

14. State collegiate scholarship.

This scheme is open only to pupils belonging to Tamilnadu or who are domiciled therein. The state collegiate scholarships will be awarded to pupils of all recognised full time college courses on the basis of the results of the public examinations conducted by the Board of Examiners of a University and whose parents income does not exceed Rs. 6000/- per annum.

15. Award of Anglo - Indian Scholarship

The Scholarships under this scheme are open to Europeans and Anglo Indians.

16. Adhoc Merit Grant to Scheduled Caste:

Scheduled Tribe Students who have secured admission in colleges (Arts and professional) will be paid at the rate of Rs.300 for each student to prosecute their studies and to purchase books. The grant is sanctioned to students, in the first degree course immediately after passing higher secondary. It is not renewable. The grant will be paid to each student irrespective of the income of the parents.

LIBRARY AND READING ROOM

1. The library is open to all the students and members of the staff of the college.
2. The library is open from 9.00 a.m. to 5.30 p.m. on all working days.
3. Identity card is compulsory for getting access to the library.

3. Loan of Books

- i) All the students of the college are eligible to borrow books from the library.
- ii) UG student is given two library cards on production of proof of his/her identity (P.G., M.Phil., - 3 cards, Ph.D. - 10 cards). One book is issued on each card. While borrowing a book the student fills in the two columns in the card and hands over the card to the library assistant at the counter and gets the book. He/she must get back his card, when he returns the book to the library.
- iii) Students should keep the card safe and they are responsible for books borrowed on their cards.
- iv) The cards are not transferable and no student shall lend his card to others. Cards so lent are liable to be forfeited.
- v) Loss of library card should be immediately reported to the librarian. A duplicate card is issued on payment of a fee Rs.10/-after waiting for a fortnight to see whether the lost card could be traced.

vi) The final year students shall return their cards to the library at the end of the sixth semester. Students of I and II year degree classes shall return their cards at the beginning of the succeeding year of their study and get fresh cards.

4. Issue and return of books

i) Books are issued to students on production of identity cards only, between 9.00 a.m & 5.30 p.m.

ii) Requisitions for books in the prescribed form available in the library should be handed over at the counter before 10 a.m.

iii) Books shall be returned to the library during the following hours. between 9.30 a.m & 4.30 p.m.

5. Period of Loan

i) Books are issued on loan ordinarily for a fortnight and the due date will be stamped in the date slip affixed to the book. For books which are on demand the period of loan is a week.

ii) Overdue charges at the rate of Re. 1 per day will be collected for the period of the books are kept beyond the due date for all days for all categories (including holidays).

iii) A book may be renewed for a further period of a fortnight provided there is no demand for it. Books must be presented at the counter for such renewals.

iv) Extension period of loan is not granted for text books.

v) Books issued for vacation should be returned within three days of reopening of the college.

vi) All the books are liable to be recalled at short notice if required.

6. Damage to Books

i) Students are responsible for loss or damage to books issued to them and solely responsible for the transaction made against the card.

ii) Marking in books with ink or pencil is considered to be serious damage.

iii) In case any book is lost or damaged in the aforesaid manner by the student he must replace the book or pay the replacement value of the book.

iv) Students on receiving the books at the counter must examine them and report to the librarian if any damage is found in the book before they leave the library. Failure to do so will make them liable for any damage that may be detected afterwards.

7. Text books on a particular subject are issued only to students studying in the faculty concerned.

8. Students are not permitted to pass or sublend books to others.

9. Reference books and rare books are not issued for use in house.

10. Reference books (Encyclopaedias, Dictionaries, Year books) and bound volumes of university question papers are issued to students for reference and use only inside the reading room on receipt of requisitions accompanied by identity cards and on no account shall these books be taken outside the library.

11. Periodicals and Newspapers should not be removed from the tables assigned to them in the reading room, and are not issued.

12. Strict silence should be observed inside the library.

CO- CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

1. SOCIAL SERVICE LEAGUE

Its aim is to instil the spirit of service and dignity of manual labour in the student.

2. NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME

The over all objective of the NSS is to render service to the community while undergoing instruction in an educational institution. It seeks to arouse the social consciousness of students and provide them with the opportunity to work with the people around the educational campuses creatively and constructively and to put the education they receive to concrete social use. Its motto is **“NOT ME BUT YOU”**. The college has four units of NSS for boys and one unit for girls. The students of the degree classes are enrolled as volunteers.

3. NATIONAL CADET CORPS

NCC Training is imparted to students of the degree classes. The college has an army wing. In addition to regular training camps, Annual Training Camp and Summer Training Camp are held. The best cadets are selected to participate in the All India Republic Day parade in New Delhi.

4. THE GANDHI STUDY CIRCLE

The main objective of the Gandhian Study Circle is to promote awareness among the students on Gandhian thought. The study circle arranges lectures, seminars, study tours etc.

5. NATIONAL INTEGRATION SAMITHI

The objective of the National Integration Samithi is to make the students realise the importance of National integration. The samithi provides the students with a forum for undergoing the importance of National Integration through debates, discussions, tours etc.

6. SPORTS AND GAMES

mhe college provides ample facilities for playing all major games including Tennis. All students are expected to take full share in games and sports activities. Only students who actually participate in sports and games are eligible for the award of certificates.
